



Strategic Report: First Term

May 2011 through July 2014

We prayerfully established four goals for our first term:

Goal 1: Establish a good foundation for language and ministry in Holland.

Goal 2: Facilitate the field by seeking to guest speak or interim so that coworkers can go on vacation or furlough.

Goal 3: Participate in the Strategic Planning of the Netherlands field.

Goal 4: Expand the camp ministry to include a teenaged winter retreat and a young adult weekend retreat.

We developed the following strategies:

Enroll Heather in a language study program for the fall of 2011. (G1)
begun November 2011

Run teen camp on July 9-15, 2011 (G4)
completed and ongoing

Begin the process to obtain residency before the end of August and hire a lawyer. (G1)
achieved

Obtain Residency within one year of arrival.

Enroll Cole in a school for the fall semester of 2011 en Luke for March 2012. (G1)
achieved

Enroll Joel in a Dutch playgroup to aid his Dutch development after the summer of 2012. (G1)
achieved September 2012

Interim pastor the Evangelical Baptist Church of Veghel so that coworkers can go on furlough. (August, 2011 - February, 2012) (G2)
completed

Attend and participate in the Strategic Planning of the Netherlands Field (June 17-19, 2012). (G3)
completed

Plan and organize a new retreat for young adults (ages 17-25) in September, 2012. (G4)
achieved and ongoing

Plan and organize a new winter retreat for teenagers in January, 2013. (G4)
achieved and ongoing

Move to Bergen op Zoom to begin partnership with John and Anna Kay Haskell before the summer of 2013. (G1 & G2)
achieved

Transition the Church planting ministry over the course of two years from the Haskells to us, so the Haskells can retire in 2015. (G1 & 2G)
started and ongoing

Prepare for and return to the United States for furlough during the second half of 2014. (G1)
completed
